Parents Survey Overview



- From 2018, Education Working Group initiates Back to School campaign in August before the school year starts.
- Data for the exercise was collected through a survey responded by the parents.
- **The main objectives of the data collection were**
 - identify the **enrollment status** of the children,
 - capture the reasons for **being out of school**,
 - identify the **main challenges faced after the earthquakes**
- **Data collection tool was accessible for both the member organizations to use during interview with their beneficiaries, and also for the *beneficiaries* to fill the survey through KoBo link autonomously.**
- **This year, the data collection process started a few months earlier with the aim of capturing the education needs and out-of-school status due to EQ.**

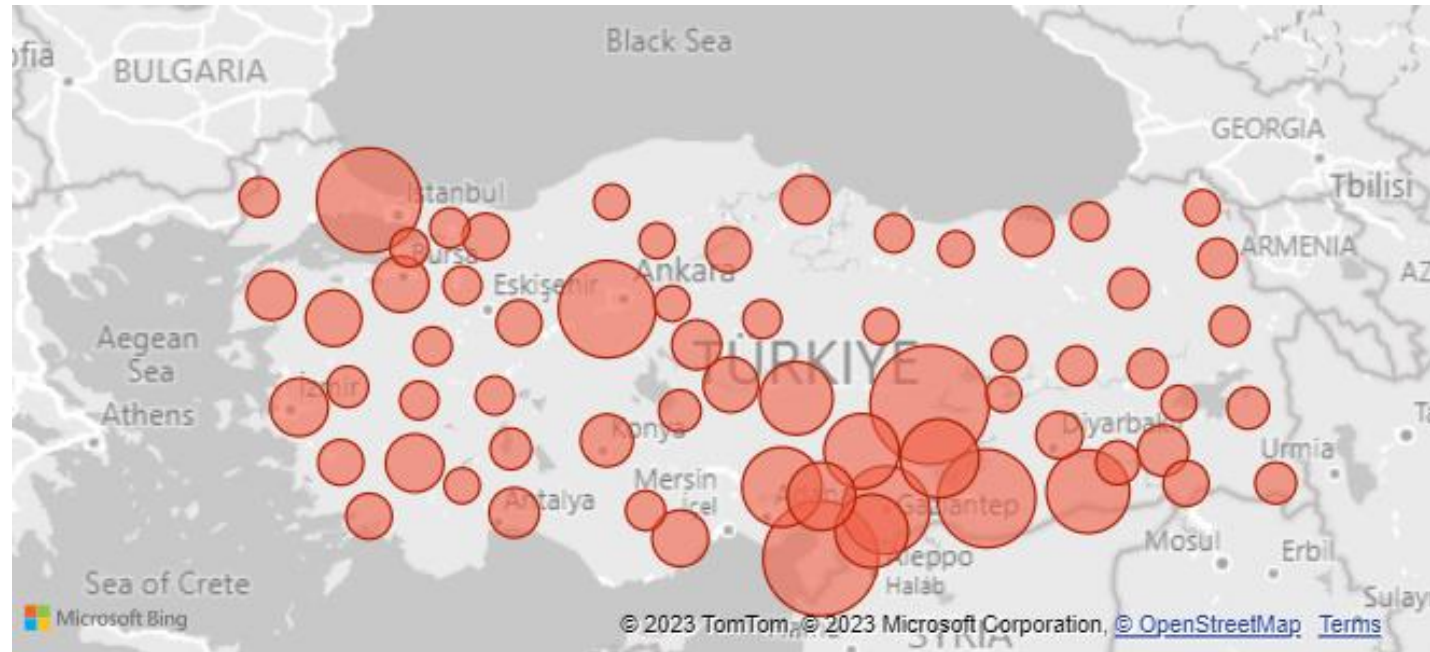

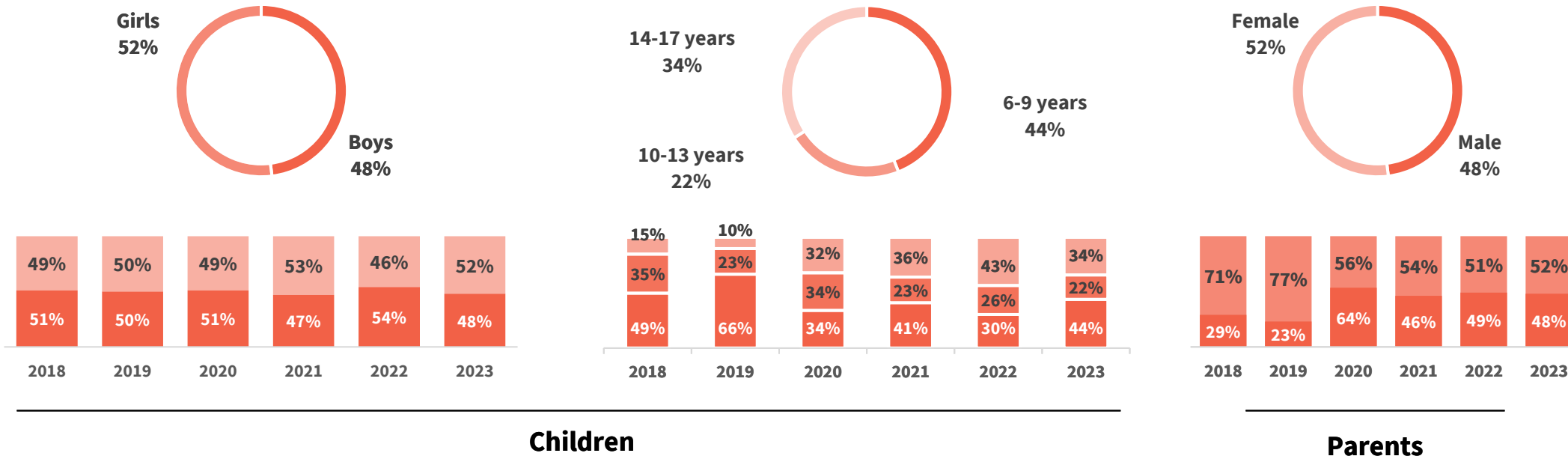

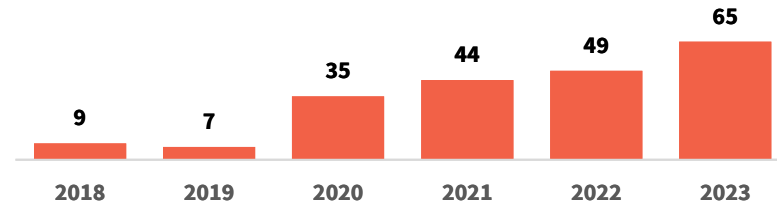

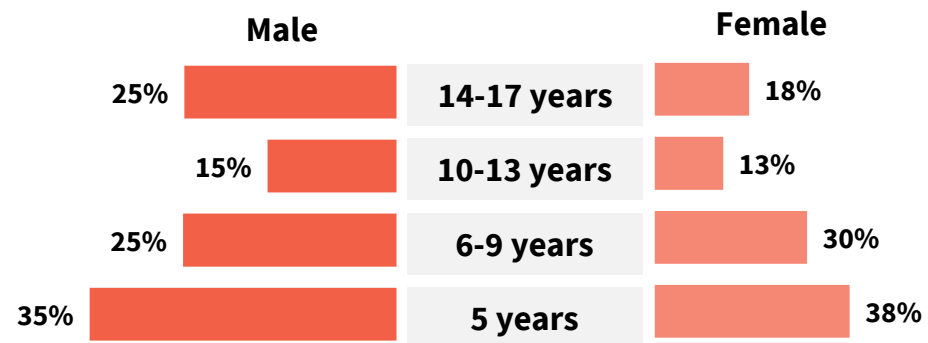


Enrolment Rate

Current Enrolment Status



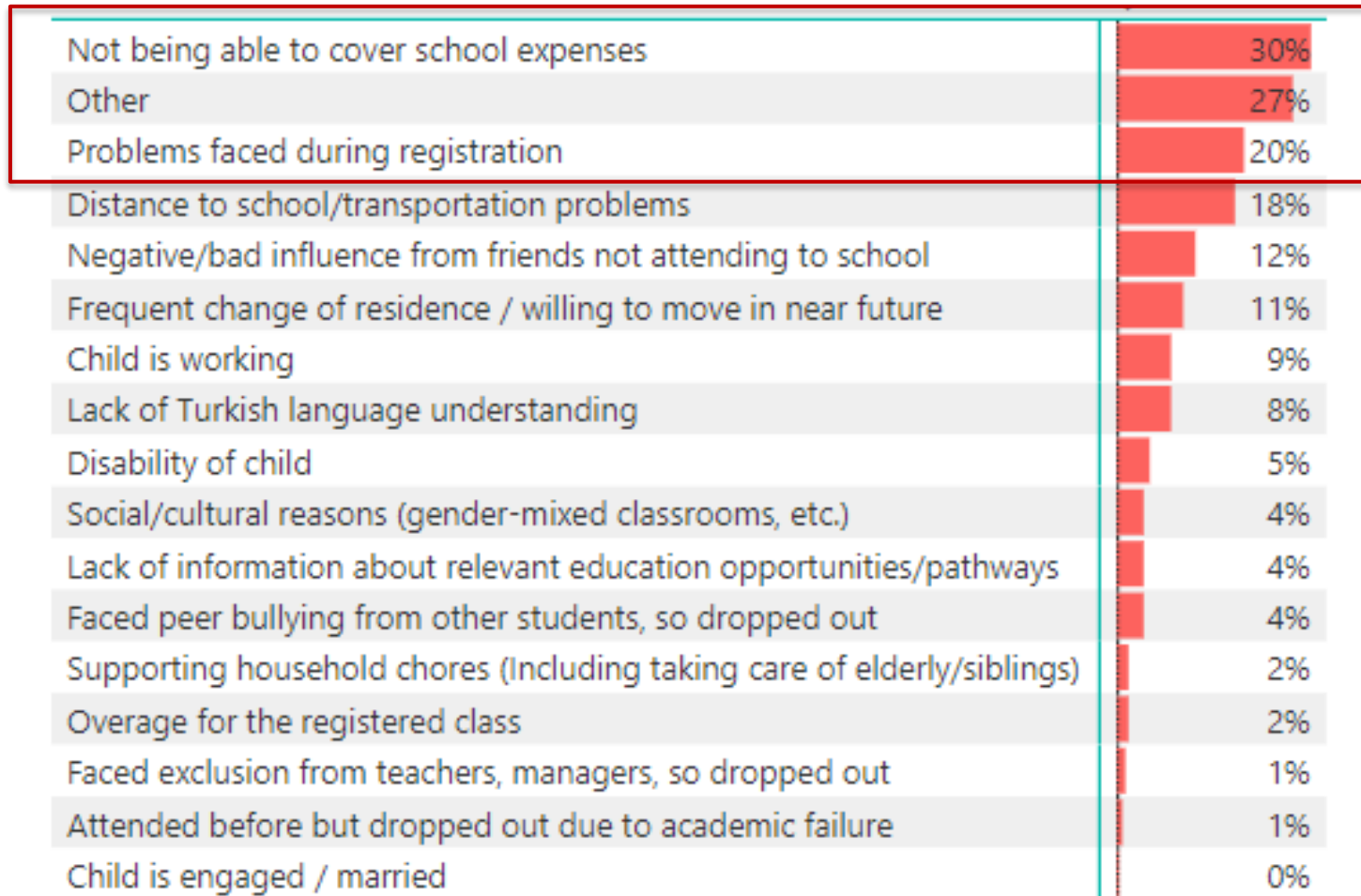
Out of school children by age and gender

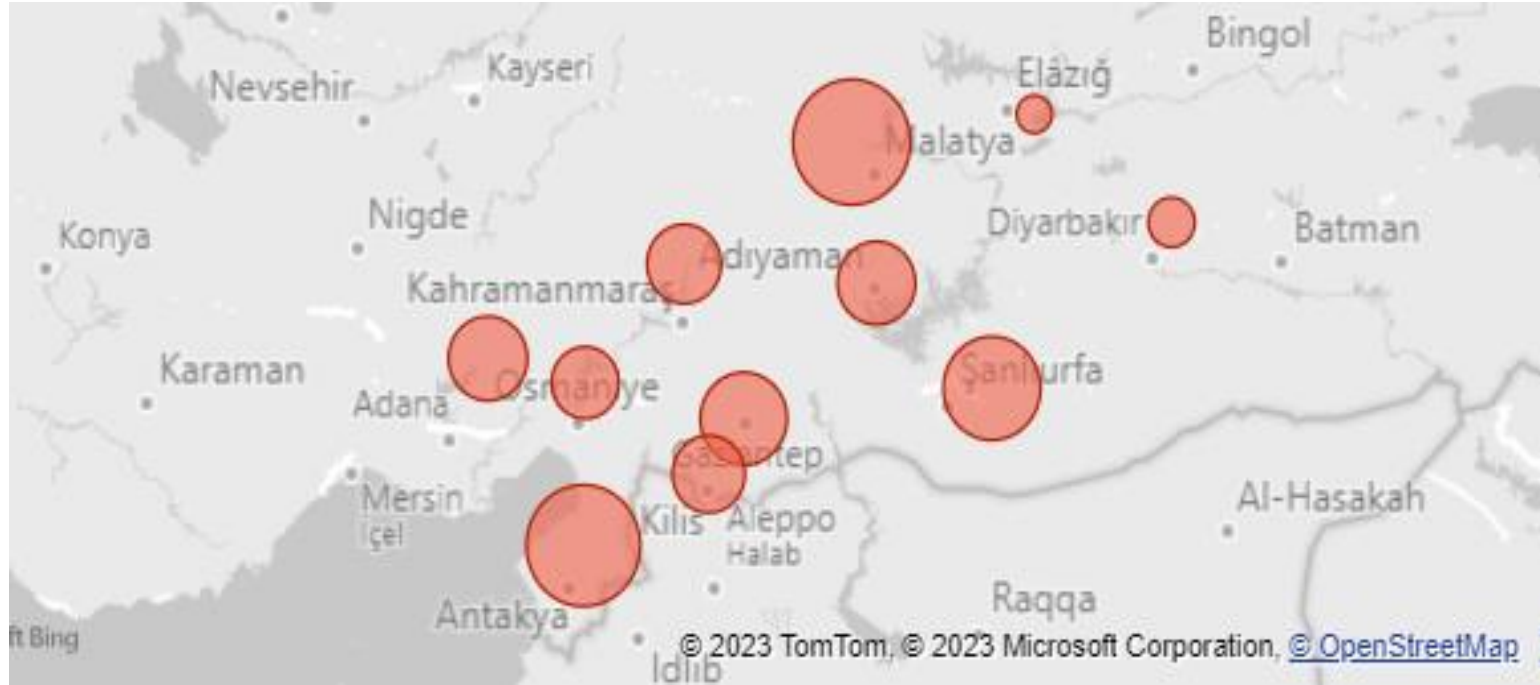
2023 BTL Sampling Overview – EQ Provinces

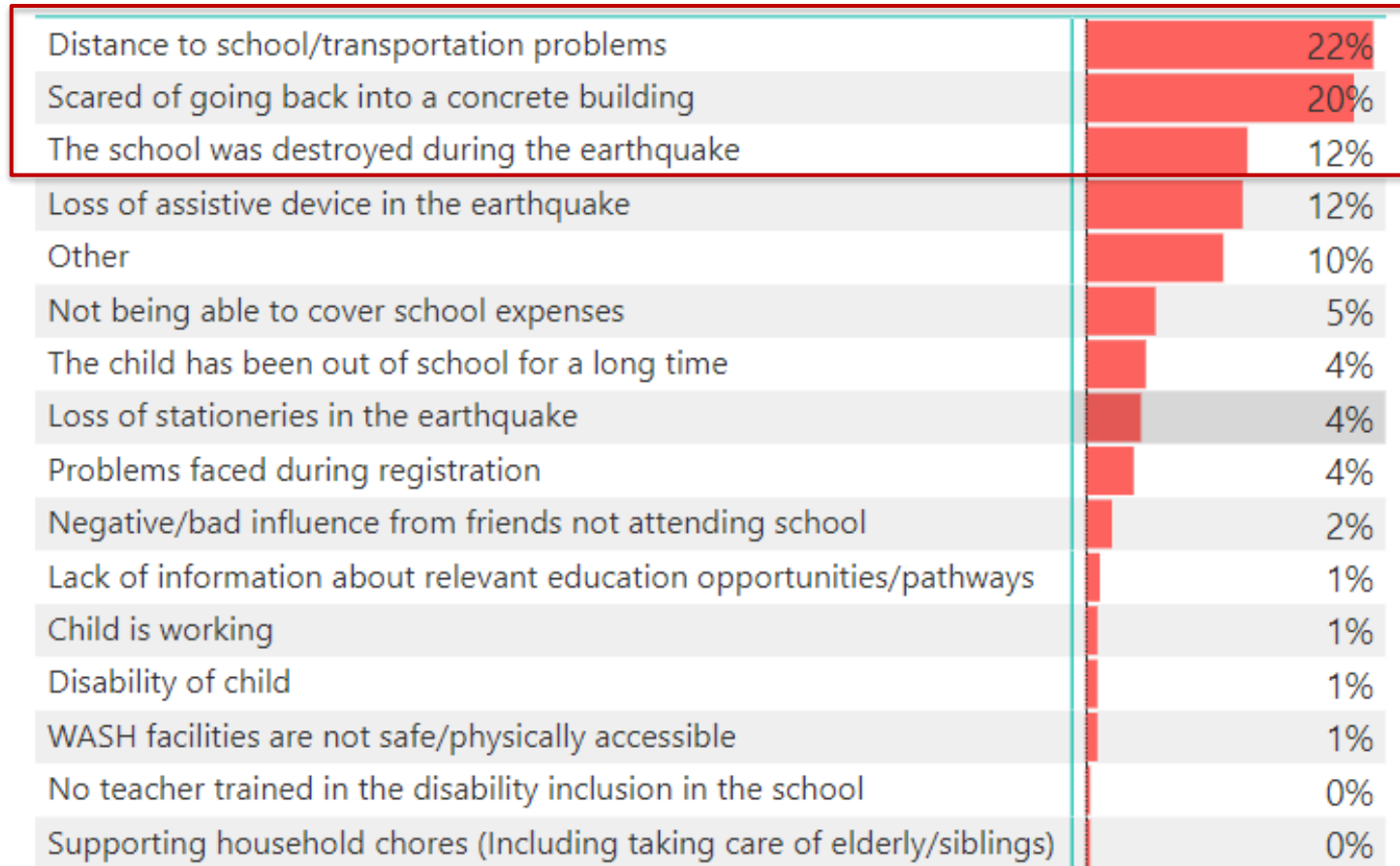

Reasons for being out of school - EQ Provinces

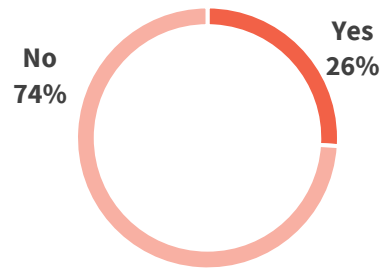


More than 50% of the reasons are EQ related.

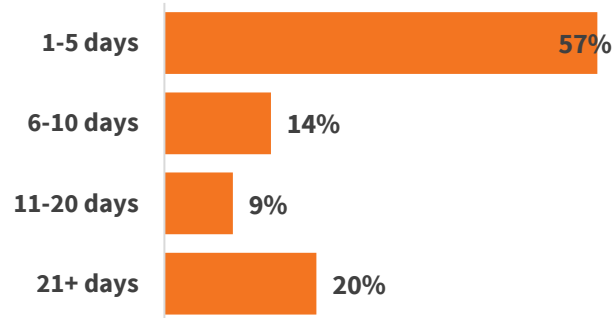
Majority of the reasons under «Other» are related to health problems and child being underage.

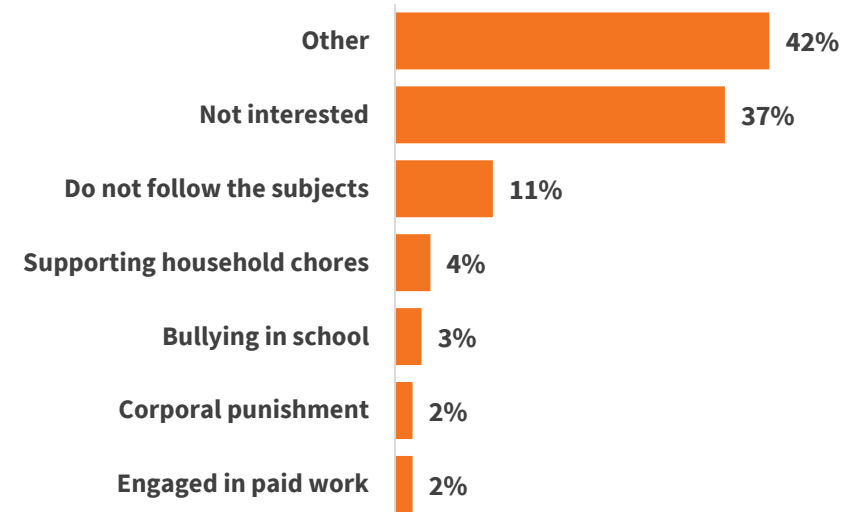
Has your household been displaced after the EQ?



How many times were your child absent in this school year?



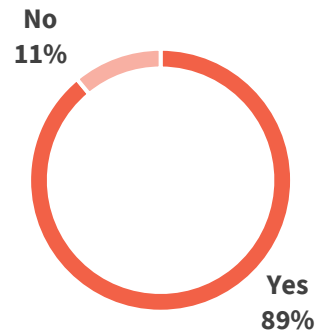
What is the main reason for their absence?

Are you planning to register your child/children in the next school year?



What is the main reason for not registering?

Not being able to cover school expenses	22%
Scared of going back into a concrete building	15%
Distance to school/transportation problems	14%
Child is working	10%
Disability of child	8%
Problems faced during registration	6%
The school was destroyed in the earthquake	6%
Negative/bad influence from friends not attending school	5%
Loss of assistive device in the earthquake	4%
Lack of information about relevant education opportunities/pathways	3%
The child has been out of school for so long	3%
Loss of stationeries in the earthquake	2%
Supporting household chores	2%
No teacher trained in disability inclusion in the school	1%
Child is engaged/married	1%
WASH facilities are not safe/physically accessible	1%
